## **GRANDPARENTS SCAM**

**If you receive a call from a “loved one” urgently requesting money for an emergency:**

- Verify the story before acting; scammers rely on urgency and fear.
- Hang up and call the “loved one” directly, or another relative, using a number you know.
- Never send money to anyone you don’t know and trust.
  - Never give out personal information to the caller.
